Co-op School Board report, Holly Babcock: The Hollis Select Board has received an offer of \$500,000 to renovate the Farley Bldg and the chair of the Select Board has asked the School Superintendent to look into the school district reclaiming the bldg. The Educational Review Committee has concluded its research. The educational review will be done by 2 outside consultants at a cost of up to \$8500 to be paid by the SAU, the Hollis School District, the Brookline School District and the Co-op School District. Public Budget Hearings are coming up: Wed Jan 27th, Wed Feb 10th, Thurs Feb 18th, Wed Mar 23rd, @ 6:30 at HBMS. Staff compensation packages are being negotiated. Farrah made a motion to support staff compensation appropriate to the high quality of education our students receive. Robin seconded. All approved by a show of hands.
