#### **Minutes of April 10, 2008**

#### **Treasurer's Report**

About \$8101 has been donated to the S-Team as a result of the mailing. The total donation will probably match last year's donation total. The balance in the account is \$13,857.60. The balance in the regular account is \$7726. \$200 was donated to the Science Olympiad. There was an income of \$93 from Hannaford.

#### **Field Day**

Emily Kalinek and Rebecca Moverman addressed PTSA and requested volunteer help and a donation for Field Day. The cost for 2 gas grills (2 x 4 feet) is \$90 per grill plus \$25 for the propane tank for a total of \$230. Marie Degulis made a motion to donate up to \$500 for Field Day. Barbara Bruinooge seconded. The motion passed. Trish MacDonald will be in charge of getting about 10 volunteers to set up and grill. The students will make a list of what they need. Field Day will be on May 29 with a rain date of May 30.
