Introduction

Minutes of May 8, 2008

Treasurer's Report

Expenses for PTSA account included \$500 donated to the Field Day barbeque, \$110 for mulch for the garden, and a small amount for extra food for staff appreciation.

Thanks to Kristen Berry for collecting the contributions for the S-Team. As of this meeting, the community has donated \$8436. Expenses for S-Team account included the buses and the cruise and \$100 donation to the school paper. The ad for the Journal has still to be paid. There was a brief discussion about the ad versus an article for next year. The majority opinion was that the article might be a better choice for next year.

Marie Degulis made a motion to amend the April minutes to say "\$50 for bus drivers." Linda Falcone seconded. The motion passed. (Please note that the minutes were actually correct but were amended for clarity.)
